

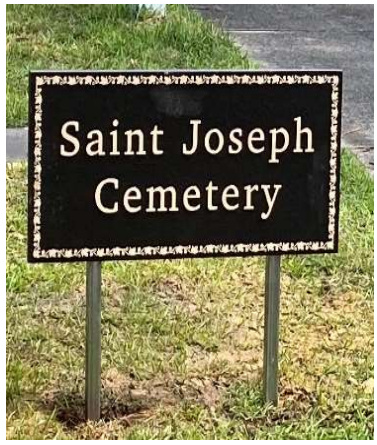

Saint Joseph Cemetery currently offers two types of plots – both full-size and cremation only. A full-size grave is 4’x8’ and can accommodate either one or two interments. You can inter one coffin and one urn or two urns within a full-size plot. Cremation only plots are 18”x18” and can accommodate one or two cremains. When purchasing a “plot”, you are paying for the “right of interment” of one or two people - and not buying real estate. Plots can be paid for in full upon selection, or you can make a deposit and pay the balance within 12 months. Before an interment can occur, any remaining balance must be satisfied.

<p><i>Once a grave has been paid in full, a natural heir to the grave(s) has the exclusive right to purchase additional “Rights of Interment,” if there is remaining space within the family plot(s). The fee required to exercise this option will be 80% of the price of a cremation plot as shown on the current Saint Joseph Cemetery Price List. In no case can more than two individuals be interred in one plot. This can be one coffin and one cremation or two cremations.</i></p>	
<p><i>Interment is defined as the place where a person is permanently laid to rest, whether they are buried or cremated.</i></p>	



- Saint Joseph Memorial Garden Rules**
- Only one flowerpot per grave – no larger than 8” in diameter
 - No other items allowed – flags will be placed on graves only on appropriate days by Saint Paul Church
 - Cut flower arrangements may be removed after three days
 - Potted plants and artificial arrangements will be removed when they become unsightly, faded, or diseased

Minimum Granite Size: 28 x 16 with (24 x 12 Bronze) Will accommodate a single individual only (buried or cremated)	Minimum Granite Size: 40 x 17 Granite (36 x 13 Bronze) Maximum Granite Size: 60 x 20 Granite (46 x 16 Bronze)	Granite must be no larger than, nor smaller than 16 x 16.
Minimum Granite Size: 28 x 18 Granite (24 x 14 Bronze) <i>can be used to accommodate companion inscription for couples cremated and buried in a single grave or for a single individual.</i>	Range for Granite for a Double Plot: 40 Inches Wide - 60 Inches Wide	Bronze must be no larger than, nor smaller than 12 x 12
Range for Granite for a Single Plot: 28 x 16 up to 40 x 17 Range for Bronze for a Single Plot: 24 x 12 up to 36 x 13	Special Note: All cremains must be placed in puncture proof vaults – such as concrete or cultured stone – for interment in Saint Joseph Cemetery, whether in cremation plots or full-size plots. NO PLASTIC LINERS are allowed; they can easily be punctured.	
Color For All Bases (full body or cremation) must be consistent with the majority. They cannot be pure grey nor white marble. Monuments delivered to Saint Joseph Cemetery require three days (3) notice for our crew to flag the gravesite to ensure proper placement of the stone by the monument company.
